

****2008 LOUISIANA DEEP SOUTH ALPACA SHOW INFORMATION****
PLEASE READ

This is an AOBA certified halter and fleece show and will be run in accordance with the 2008 AOBA Show Handbook. The show will be judged using 60/40 basis with fleece as 60% and confirmation as 40%. Any questions can be directed to:

All alpacas must be registered and entered in the name of the owner as listed on the ARI Registration Certificate. A "Buyer's Permission to Show" form signed by the owner as listed on the ARI Registration Certificate, must accompany an exhibitor other than the listed owner.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: All alpacas from Texas must have a health certificate completed within 30 days of the last day of the show(Nov. 16). Texas alpacas 12 months old and older are required to be Brucellosis tested negative. A negative Brucellosis test done at any time will be acceptable. All other alpacas from other states must have a health certificate completed within 30 days of the last day of the show(Nov. 16). All alpacas must be microchipped with the microchip number, BVD negative test results, & the alpaca's ARI name on the health certificate. Health certificates & microchip verification will be checked at registration.

Bring a copy of the health certificate as the copy will be retained by the show superintendent.

BVD PCR TEST: All alpacas must have a documented BVD PCR or VI negative test. This includes all alpacas registered to show, all companion alpacas, and any other alpacas coming into the Monroe Civic Center. Please direct all questions relating to BVD PCR tests to Donna Johnson, show superintendent.

There is no predetermined time limitation on this test. If you have a prior negative BVD PCR or VI for each animal entered that test will be acceptable. It is understood that an alpaca can be exposed and infected at any time. The virus will run its course and the alpaca will build immunities of its own and then return to a normal healthy state. An alpaca will then test negative on PCR tests once the virus has been fought and won by the alpaca.

Test procedures:

1. Proof of BVD PCR or VI Negative test for each alpaca must be indicated on the Health Certificate at check-in.
2. Schedule tests early & allow 3 to 4 weeks for results.

CHECK-IN PROCEDURE:

Vet check, microchip check & BVD check done at the same time **at exhibitor's trailer**. Proceed to show ring for color checking then surrender vet papers and pick up show packet at registration desk. If you would like to keep your vet papers, please make a copy before leaving home. The show will retain a copy of the health certificate. **ALL ALPACAS MUST BE VET CHECKED BEFORE ENTERING THE ARENA. This is for the health & safety of all alpacas.**

Veterinarian on call for the show will be announced.

Exhibitors will be billed directly for any services performed.

Alpacas must be vet checked, microchip checked and color checked Thursday, Nov. 13, between 1pm & 6 pm or Friday, Nov. 14, between 8 am to 9 pm. Doors will lock down at 10 pm. Over night security provided by Monroe Police Dept.

Check-out is Sunday, November 16, AFTER completion of classes. Please do not tear down before end of the show.

Mandatory exhibitors meeting on Saturday, November 15 @ 8:30 am. Show starts at 9 am.

Get of Sire and Produce of Dam entries are made in the name of the sire or dam with a \$20 entry fee. A copy of the sire's or dam's ARI Certificate & copies of each offspring's ARI Certificate must accompany your entry & will be retained by the show superintendent. Get of Sire entries must be from three different dams.

NEW FLEECE LENGTHS FOR YEARLING SURIS FULL FLEECE CLASS

1. Shorn within 12 months of the 1st day of scheduled judging (Fleece Length: 3"- 9")
2. Not previously shorn (Fleece Length: 3"- no maximum)

Stalls are 10 x 10 corral panels on concrete floor with cardboard bedding provided. Limit 3 alpacas per stall. Corral panels supplied by Wade Presley of Dryco Manufacturing.

Vendor space will be located in the front lobby.
